We are invited to share in an Ash Wednesday service at Trinity Church, Codsall on 18<sup>th</sup> February at 7.00 p.m.

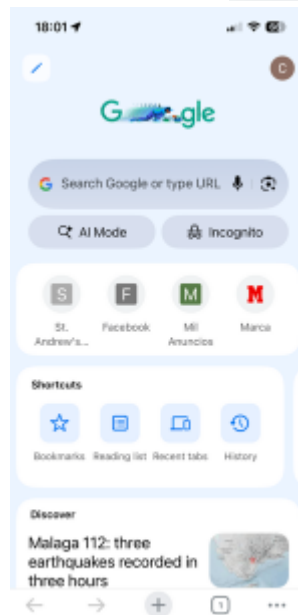
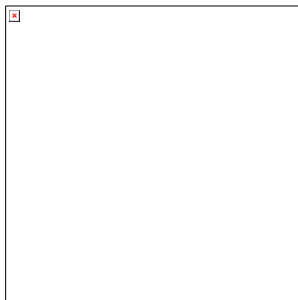
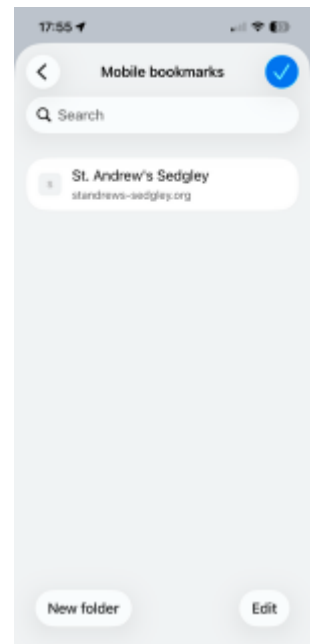
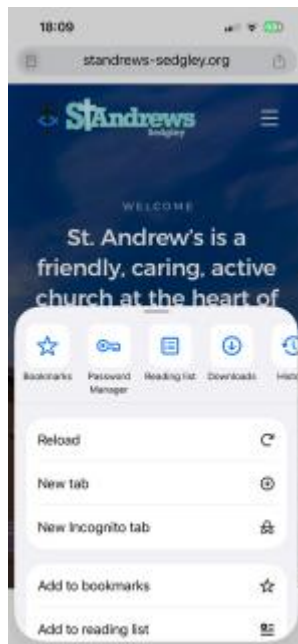
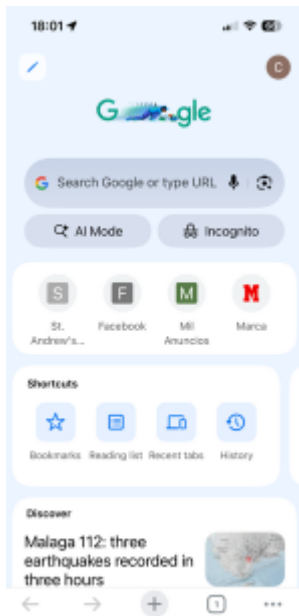
## **A note from our Circuit MWiB Committee**
